Your ideas about what you'd like to accomplish when you first come into the space will likely change dramatically over the course of the residency.

That being said, this section is for you to tell us about your anticipated creative process. How will you evolve your ideas and adapt them for Audium's system?

Residency artists will be creating an immersive experience; you will be composing sounds and projections for the lobby and entry hallway as well as a sound composition that you will perform, live, in the actual performance space. Keep this in mind as you answer the question below.
